

## **MOUNT SOUTHINGTON RANGER PROGRAM**

Thank you for your interest in the Ranger program at Mount Southington. The Ranger program is an all-volunteer program with a National Ski Patrol affiliation. Rangers at Mount Southington perform ambassador duties along with assisting Ski Patrol and Management with various duties.

First year Rangers are considered Candidates and are on a one season probation period. Second year and beyond Rangers are required to have CPR training and take a National Ski Patrol Outdoor First Care course. Both the CPR and the OFC course are 2-year certifications and taught at Mount Southington free of charge by our Ski Patrol. Candidates are not required to take either course until the beginning of their second year. Candidates are trained by management their first year. After completion of the first year, and meeting all the requirements of a candidate year, the OFC and CPR will be offered preseason.

Rangers commit to one 4-hour shift per week for the season, the same 4-hour shift for the entire season. Rangers need to be advanced skiers or riders, to be able to withstand winter temperatures and weather. A uniform Jacket will be provided for each Ranger.

Rangers will be interacting with our guests for their entire shift and are expected to be professional and courteous.

The Mountain provides each Ranger with a season pass. Other benefits are available and will be covered in the first interview.

Second year and beyond Rangers (returning Rangers) will receive an email in September and will renew their commitment for the coming season. Candidates will not be interviewed or hired until after Mid-October.
